The Faculty of Graphic Design has joined the international green design organization: LEARNING NETWORK ON SUSTAINABILITY INTERNATIONAL – LENS. This organization includes 36 universities from Europe, Asia, Africa, South America, and Central America, aiming to promote a new generation of designers capable of contributing to the transition towards a sustainable society for all.

Among them, nearly 20 lectures belong to the general education courses that are used in all training programs

This achievement demonstrates the wisdom and deep sense of responsibility of FPT University lecturers in educating SDGs for students. Although it is difficult to add new knowledge to the formal curriculum due to the rigorous process of its development, CONTENT ON SDGs has been added to seminars, workshops, practical exercises. and extracurricular activities of FPT University. This also reflects the university's emphasis on SDG-related content in its future development strategy. Especially from the school year 2021-2022, SDGs content is included in the Orientation program for all new students.

Education for the sake of the SDGs presents teachers and students with problems that need to be solved with broad, interdisciplinary knowledge. Therefore, in the plan to build **AN SDGS-INTEGRATED TRAINING PROGRAM FOR THE YEARS 2021 AND 2022**, FPT University has included many interdisciplinary academic activities, creating a new playground for education for the SDGs

The understanding, responsibility, and actions for SDGs from instructors have spread to FPT students.

When we conducted **A SURVEY OF COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES FOR SDGs** at FPT University, the results revealed that, where the activities of instructors are strong, there are similarities in the activities of their students.

FPT University attempts to have dedicated educational outreach activities for the big community. The university's instructors and students have been encouraging **EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES TO LOCAL JUNIOR STUDENTS**, such as coding, foreign languages, and soft skills. Thanks to FPT University's management strategy for sustainable development, **THE PLAN FOR EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH ACTIVITIES FROM 2021** will focus on more content related to the Sustainable Development Goals.
