### Collecting plastic waste at the beaches



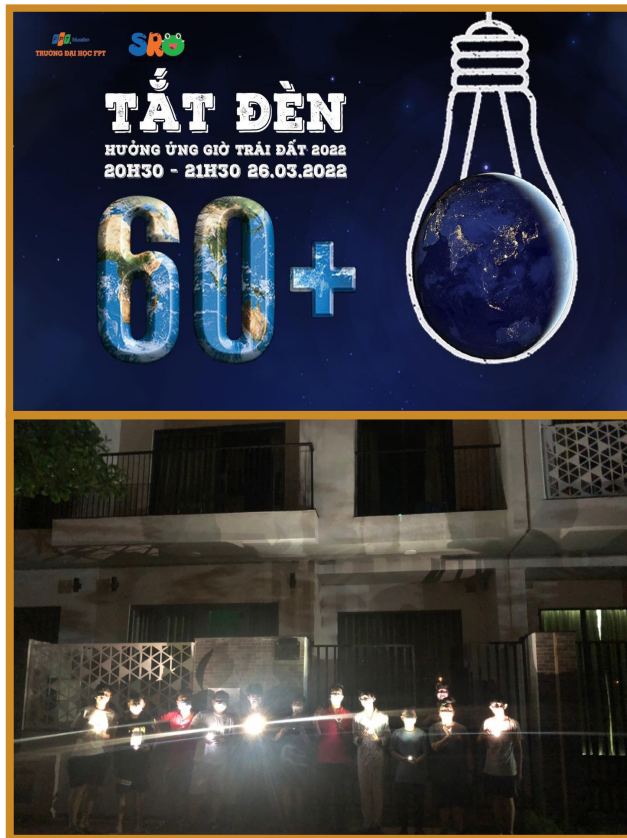

Many FPTU students participated in the project, which resulted in the exchange of 1014 items, including 682 clothes (equivalent to the reduction of 1,026 kg of CO2 emissions into the atmosphere).
