Man-made lakes of FPTU

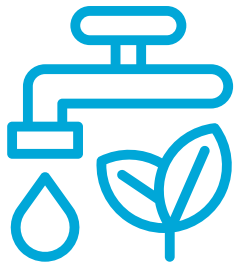

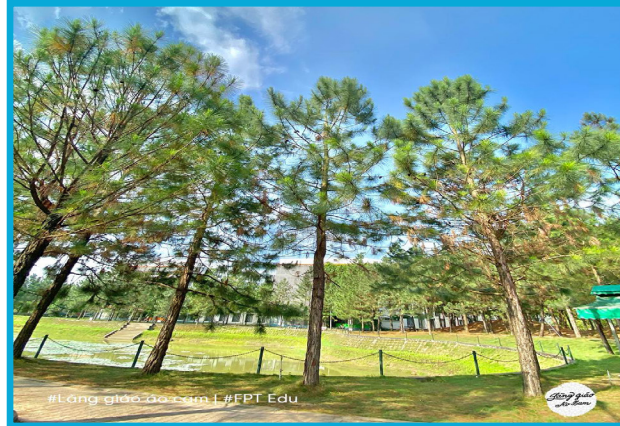
Free drinking water



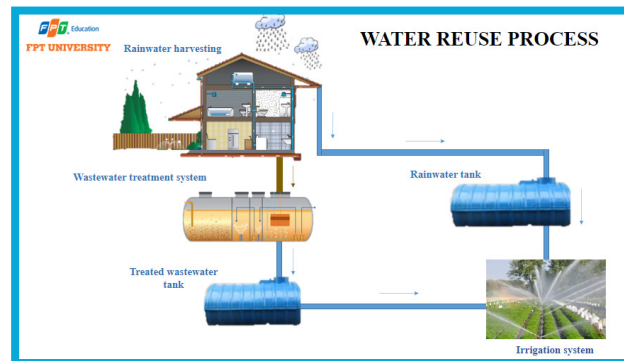
The university provides free drinking water that meets the daily demand of students, staff, and visitors on all campuses.
