Happiness Within Our Reach

Thu Duc Youth Village, established in 1975, provides shelter for orphans, abandoned children, and those in difficult circumstances. The "Happiness Within Our Reach" Project by students from the Soft Skills Department, raises funds to give gifts to these children, aiming to instill hope and resilience in them through the love and generosity of the community.



Bup Phe Project

"Bup Phe" is a charitable project by students from the Soft Skills Department, aiming to help those in need experience a proper buffet meal. The project organized 80 vegetarian buffet meals (100k VND per meal) and donated 800 kg of rice to those in difficult circumstances, with total donations amounting to over 15 million VND.





The Happiness Project

"The Happiness" project, by students from the Soft Skills Department, aims to raise funds to help elderly homeless individuals living on the streets at night have better meals. The project raised over 11.5 million VND and distributed 200 gift packages to the homeless along Le Van Viet and Phan Dang Luu streets in Ho Chi Minh City.
