Hope School, established in 2021 on the initiative of FPT Corporation, welcomes, nurtures, and educates children orphaned by the COVID-19 pandemic. This year, the school inaugurated a new campus at FPT City, Da Nang.

Orange Shirts in U Minh Thuong

“Orange Shirts in U Minh Thuong” is a weekly community program led by FPTU Can Tho students. Despite the sweltering July heat, students traveled to An Minh Bac Kindergarten in Kien Giang Province—a remote, under-resourced area in Vietnam’s far south—to help refurbish the school. They cleaned and repainted aging walls, cleared overgrowth, and planted 500 pink trumpet trees along both sides of the road.
