All buildings have earned national and international green design certifications.



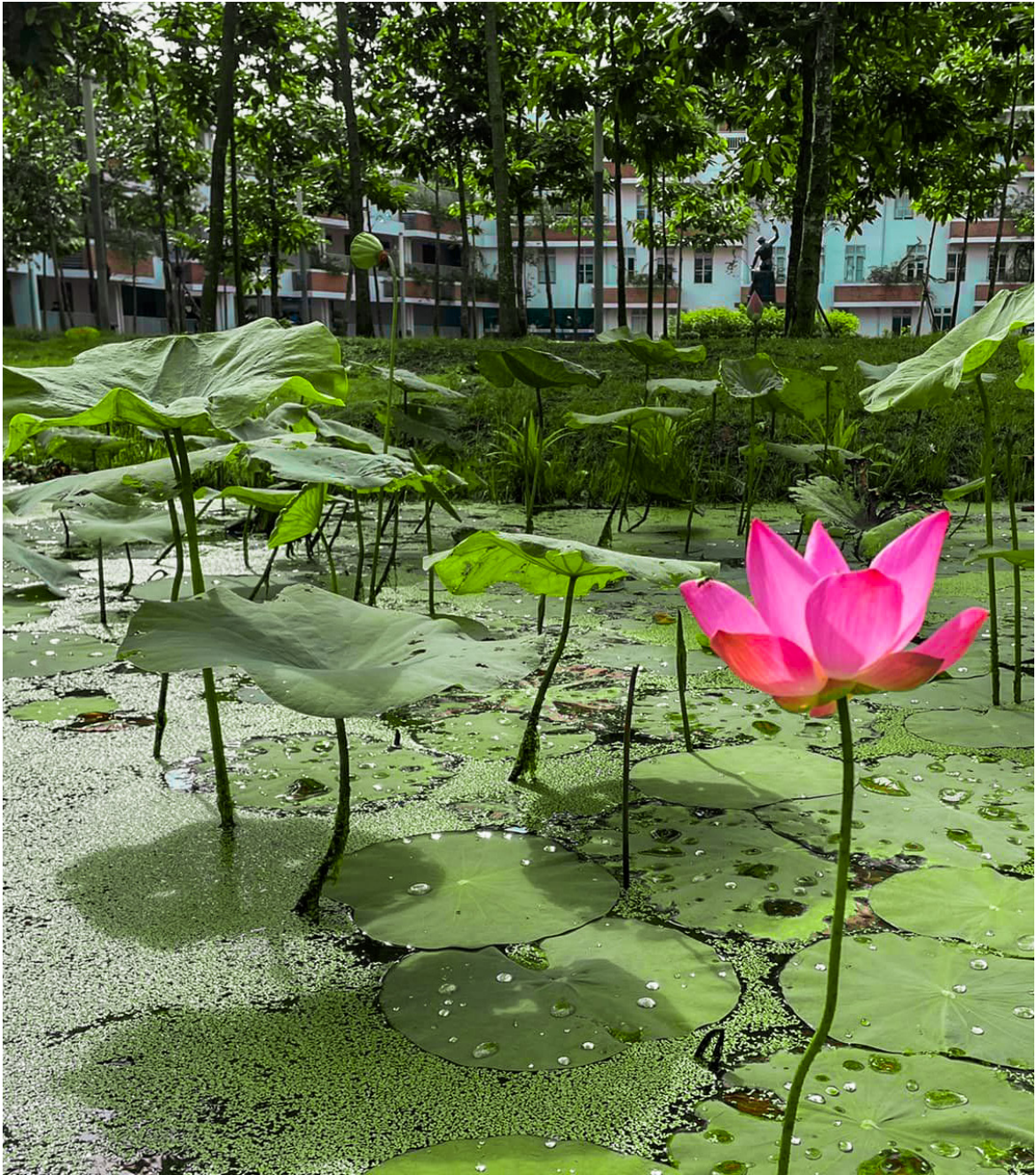


The verdant landscape, rich with trees, flowers, and lakes, creates an exquisitely poetic setting that defines FPTU’s campuses

With SEA Games medalists among the instructors, the program promotes respect and humanity. Students gain calmness and clarity, preparing for life’s challenges. Various competitions like “Viet Vo Anh Hung Tranh Doat Coc Vung” and “FPT Edu Khoi nguon Vo Viet” inspire them.
